Our first teachers' training meeting was held in order to discuss different reading strategies and to compile a guide

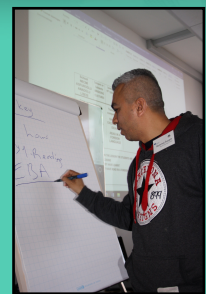
Our collaboration was very fruitful. Every nation presented five different reading strategies it has already implemented in its language lessons. After that we had a vivid discussion and reflection of the activities.

The next day, language teachers introduced how literature/language lessons are taught at their school using a PPP. Every nation drew its conclusions being part of the final guide.

To enhance the team spirit, we visited the print museum in Borken and created a poster using former printing techniques in mixed groups so that every nation was represented in one group.

As the culture of each partner also plays an important role in the project, we visited the Cologne Cathedral and the treasure chamber of the Cathedral. On another day we went to Essen, an important town in the Ruhrgebiet area, where we visited the “Zeche Zollverein” representing mining in the Ruhrgebiet. After that we gained an insight into the life of the Krupp family.
