This LTTA was hosted in Paikuse, Estonia from 25th to 29th March 2019. Under the Erasmus+ programme and the project we share - the participants that attended it were the following ones:

Four students and two teachers from Spain, Turkey, Germany, four students and three teachers from France.

The main idea was to share and learn from our European colleagues with some workshops, activities, examples and experiences related to Literacy.

During those days as a school coordinator, we have had the extra responsibility of combining final products and project growing. A challenge that was shared by all project partners, before, during and after the meeting. That's why we were involved doing some workshops and they also were indicators of achievement of our main goals in our project.

The details of this visit are the following ones:

As usual the mobility started with opening ceremony, with a welcome speech by the headmaster and some songs by the school choir. A guided tour with the student-guides at school was followed. Then the students attended the lessons together with their hosts. At the same time the project partners had 20 min presentation of each school on competences, discussion and reflection on the activities. All the partners had prepared thoroughly and the presentations offered high interest and were educative.

After lunch the students had some warm-up activities and preparation for the workshop next day. The preparation was connected with story writing. The students chose different words and formed the mind-maps with them. They worked in mixed groups.

In the evening all the guests went sightseeing tour in Pärnu.

The second day belonged to a visit to the island Kihnu which is the World Heritage Site. Everybody enjoyed the trip as it was unbelievable how people had preserved








